HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1617, L. D. 1177, "Resolve, Regulating Fishing in Round Pond and Fry Pan Pond, Somerset County."

Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of $7\frac{1}{2}$ pounds of fish per person from Moose river from Brassua dam to Moosehead lake.
