#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Harry Lutterman, of Waterville.

Harry Lutterman; compensated. Resolved: That the sum of \$975 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund to be paid to Harry Lutterman, of Waterville, for vacation pay due him during the 3 years from 1943 to 1946, inclusive, while in the employ of the Maine Maritime Academy as chief commissary officer.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

The amount of this resolve represents vacation pay due that was never paid to Mr. Lutterman.
