# RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Elmer W. Lawrence, of Pittsfield.

Elmer W. Lawrence; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Elmer W. Lawrence, of Pittsfield, who was injured while in the employ of the state highway commission. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1951 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be paid from the general highway fund.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Lawrence is about 48 years of age. He was injured on May 22, 1940 when a gravel pit slid upon him. He is unable to work.
