RESOLVE, in Favor of Lewiston-Auburn Catholic Bureau of Social Service, Inc., of Lewiston.

Lewiston-Auburn Catholic Bureau of Social Service, Inc., appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954, and the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955, to be paid to Lewiston-Auburn Catholic Bureau of Social Service, Inc., of Lewiston, to aid them in their social service work.

The social service rendered by the bureau is given to all races and creeds and has done a great deal to keep families together as a unit of society.
