RESOLVE, in Favor of George L. McLellan, of Lamoine.

George L. McLellan; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$1,000 to be paid to George L. McLellan, of Lamoine, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for damage to his property by the state highway commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In the course of construction of State Aid road No. 4, in the town of Lamoine, the state of Maine, without permission, entered on two or more lots of land owned by George L. McLellan, causing damage to each lot to the amount of \$500.
