IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Certain Food Products from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 81, § 6, sub-§ XVI, amended. Subsection XVI of section 6 of chapter 81 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'XVI. Property in the possession of a common carrier while in interstate transportation or held en route awaiting further transportation to the destination named in a through bill of lading; and food products while stored in the custody of a warehouseman as defined in chapter 40, awaiting shipment outside the state, provided said food products were packed within the state and provided the principal ingredients thereof were grown or produced within the state or brought to the state directly from the sea.'
