STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT to Increase the Fee Allowed Official Motor Vehicle Inspection Stations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 37, amended. Section 37 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 37. Fee for licenses. The operator of any official inspection station shall conduct the inspection of motor vehicles presented to him for that purpose in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by the secretary of state, for which he shall receive a fee of $\frac{500}{500}$ 75c for each car inspected, this sum not to include labor or material used in correction of faults in equipment.'
