SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 400, L. D. 453, Resolve Appropriating Moneys to Effectuate Salary Plan for State Employees.

Amend said Resolve by striking out the figures "\$400,000" in the 2nd line of the 6th paragraph and inserting in place thereof the figures "\$50,000".

Further amend said Resolve by striking out the punctuation and words ", as of the week ending July 5, 1952," in the 3rd and 4th lines of the 6th paragraph.

Further amend said Resolve by adding after the 6th paragraph, the following:

Resolved: That the provisions of this resolve shall become effective for the 2nd payroll period next following the effective date of this resolve; and be it further:
