COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 432, L. D. 479, Bill "An Act  
Creating a Board of Examiners of  
Psychologists."

Amend said Bill by striking out the underlined words  
"with the advice and consent of the aforementioned council"  
in the 11th and 12th lines of section 1, and inserting in  
place thereof the underlined words 'and his executive council'.

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined  
semicolon after the underlined words "United States" in sub-  
section III of section 3 and adding the underlined words and  
punctuation 'or has filed application for naturalization;'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined  
words "less than \$100, nor more than \$500" in the 5th line of  
section 7 and inserting in place thereof the underlined words  
'more than \$300'.
