STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Road Repair Tax Fund in the Townships of Alder Stream, Coburn Gore, Chain of Ponds, and Jim Pond.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Excise tax in certain townships reallocated. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 46 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, the county treasurer of the county of Franklin shall set up a special road repair tax fund for the townships of Alder Stream, Coburn Gore, Chain of Ponds, and Jim Pond. All excise taxes received by the treasurer from payments by residents of these townships shall be paid into this fund for use on the various roads in these townships as will benefit the residents of all the said townships.
