RESOLVE, Closing Parker Pond, Cumberland County, to Ice Fishing.

Parker pond; closed to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to close Parker pond, situated wholly in the town of Casco, county of Cumberland, to all ice fishing except during the months of February and March.
