STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT to Exempt the Sale of Meals by Hospitals and Nursing Homes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14-A, § 10, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 10 of chapter 14-A of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 250 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

Provided, however, meals, food and drink served to patients and inmates of hospitals licensed by the state for the care of human beings and other institutions licensed by the state for the hospitalization or nursing care of human beings shall be deemed "food products."
