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**AN ACT Relating to Leases of Island Shores for Penobscot Tribe of  
Indians.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 350, amended.** Section 350 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 350. Lease of island shores; rents of shores.** The shores of the islands in the Penobscot river belonging to said tribe shall be leased for booming or hitching logs under the orders of the department. Such leases shall not run longer than 5 years. All sums received from rent of said shores shall be paid to the state, to be held in trust, and paid to said tribe as provided in section 1 of chapter 267 of the special laws of 1873 owners of the shores leased.'
