STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Dividends and Interest for Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 337-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 337-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 337-A. Dividends and interest. All income, dividends and interest of whatever source accruing for the benefit of the Penobscot tribe of Indians and heretofore paid into the general fund of the state shall be distributed pro rata to each member of the tribe on the census list.'
