AN ACT Relating to the Sale of Liquor on May Thirtieth.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 57, § 22-C, amended. Section 22-C of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 102 of the public laws of 1949, and as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence, to read as follows :

'No liquor shall be sold in this state on May 30.'
