STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Towns and Counties Relative to Hearings for Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 22, amended. Section 22 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding after the 1st sentence thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'The state, upon properly approved vouchers submitted by the municipal officers of a town or the county commissioners, shall from the funds of the Maine state liquor commission reimburse such town or county for expenses incurred on the applications for liquor licenses requiring the approval of such municipal officers or such counties.'
