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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Medway.**

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**Town of Medway; reimbursed. Resolved:** That the sum of \$399 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Medway, to reimburse said town for medical aid extended to Myrtle Brophy, state pauper; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It was known by the town overseers of Medway that Mrs. Brophy did not have a settlement in the town of Medway when these medical bills to Dr. Sullivan were made. After a thorough investigation it was learned that Mrs. Brophy did not have a settlement in any town. She has been accepted by the state bureau of health and welfare as a state case and it is felt that the state should make full reimbursement to the town of Medway. The total amount of the bills for the period from December 1950 to June 1952 was \$822. The town has received \$423 from the state, leaving a balance of \$399 due.
