**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Reconditioning Buildings at the
Maine Vocational-Technical Institute.**

Maine Vocational-Technical Institute; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$60,000 to the state department of education to continue the reconditioning of buildings at Fort Preble, South Portland, occupied by the Maine Vocational-Technical Institute; and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse but remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The buildings at Fort Preble now house the complete operations of the Maine Vocational-Technical Institute. It is necessary that more work be done toward permanent preservation of the buildings.
