STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Certain Policies of Insurance by Companies Organized Under General Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 56, § 25, sub-§ XVI, additional. Section 25 of chapter 56 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered XVI, to read as follows:

'XVI. Any policy insuring against liability resulting from or incident to the ownership, maintenance or use of a vehicle or aircraft may contain a provision for payment on behalf of the injured party or for reimbursement of the insured for payment, irrespective of legal liability of the insured, of medical, hospital, surgical and disability benefits to persons injured and funeral and death benefits to dependents, beneficiaries or personal representatives of persons who are killed as the result of an accident, and such provision shall not be deemed to be an accident insurance policy,'
