**AN ACT Relating to Benefits for Partial Unemployment Under
Employment Security Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 24, § 13, sub-§ III, amended. Subsection III of section 13 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 430 of the public laws of 1949, and as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows :

‘III. Weekly benefit for partial unemployment. On and after September 1, 1949, each eligible individual who is partially unemployed and who has earned less than his weekly benefit amount in any week shall be paid with respect to such week a partial benefit. Such partial benefit shall be the individual’s weekly benefit amount reduced by the amount shown in column (C) in the schedule below on the line on which in column (A) there is indicated the individual’s weekly earning class. The individual’s weekly earning class shall be determined by the wages earned by him during the week for which he claims a partial benefit as shown in column (B).
