IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Persons Treating for Gunshot Wounds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 124, § 18-A, additional. Chapter 124 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 18-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 18-A. Treating of gunshot wounds. Any person who treats a human being for a wound apparently caused by the discharge of a firearm shall immediately report the same to the county attorney or sheriff of the county in which the wound was treated. Whoever fails to so report any such treatment shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.'
