**AN ACT Relating to Renewal of Certificates of Registration for
Hairdressing and Beauty Culture.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 214, amended. Section 214 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'However, no certificate as set forth in sections 205 to 222, inclusive, shall be renewed after a period of 2 years, unless said person has completed, at least, 6 consecutive hours of educational study at a school of beauty culture and hairdressing, or at a state association convention within each period of 2 years.'
