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AN ACT Relating to Canning of Clams.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**R. S., c. 34, § 93, repealed and replaced.** Section 93 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof :

**'Sec. 93. Canning of clams regulated.** No clams, either fresh shucked or steamed, shall be canned in any manner or in any type containers between June 15th and September 15th, inclusive, in any year. The provisions of this section shall not apply to hotels, restaurants, roadside stands and similar places which shuck clams on their place of business for consumption on the premises.

Whoever violates any provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of \$5 for each bushel of clams involved.'
