AN ACT Relating to Taxation of Television Sets.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 81, § 6, sub-§ IV, amended. Subsection IV of section 6 of chapter 81 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 182 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby further amended to read as follows :

IV. The household furniture excluding radios **and television sets** of each person, not exceeding \$500 to any one household, his wearing apparel, farming utensils and mechanics' tools necessary for his business.'
