STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Town's Share for State Aid Reconstruction.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 29, amended. Section 29 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding after the 1st paragraph thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding paragraph, if any town shall appropriate a maximum of 4 units, for use only in reconstructing improved state aid highways, the commission shall from any balance of said fund for state aid highways, and subject to the provisions of section 30, apportion a like increase of state aid.'
