STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Excise Taxes on Malt Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 20, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 20 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'A wholesale licensee who imports malt liquor shall pay an excise tax on the following basis: 16c a gallon; case containing 24 12-ounce bottles, 36c; case containing 24 16-ounce bottles, 48c; case containing 12 24-ounce bottles, 36c case containing 12 32 ounce bottles, 48c: \$4.96 for a barrel; \$2.48 for a half-barrel; and \$1.24 for a quarter-barrel.'
