AN ACT Relating to Fees for Retail Sale of Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 22-F, amended. The first 2 paragraphs of section 22-F of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 85 of the public laws of 1949, are hereby amended to read as follows:

'Hotel—Spirituous, ~~and~~ vinous **and malt liquor** (in cities or towns having population of 10,000 or more) \$600.00
Hotel—Spirituous, ~~and~~ vinous **and malt liquor** (in cities or towns having population of less than 10,000) 300.00'
