HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to House Amendment "A" to H. P. 1132,
L. D. 1282, Bill "An Act to Authorize
Issuance of Bonds in the Amount of Twenty
Million Dollars for Bonus to Maine
Veterans of World War II and Korean
Campaign."

Amend said Amendment by striking out the last paragraph
thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section
10 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 10. Spanish War Bonus. Each honorably discharged
soldier and sailor or member of the armed forces, resident
of the state of Maine who served in the quota of Maine in the
war with Spain, shall be paid a bonus of \$78 from the
"Veterans' Bonus Fund". The "Veterans' Bonus Board" is hereby
authorized and directed to determine the validity of the
claims filed with the board for said bonus. The claims so
approved by the board shall be forwarded to the state con-
troller for payment.'
