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**RESOLVE, Providing for the Printing of "Maine Pollen Survey."**

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**"Maine Pollen Survey;" printing of. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2,285 from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to be paid to the Division of Public Printing of the Bureau of Purchases for the printing of "Maine Pollen Survey."

**STATEMENT OF FACTS**

The 94th Legislature, by chapter 140 of the resolves, 1949, provided for a pollen and fungus survey of Maine. The survey work has been completed and the results would be of great value if they could be printed and distributed among in-state and out-of-state agencies interested in knowing of the pollen-free areas in a vacation state. The sum provided for in this resolve will print 3,000 copies of the survey.
