STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Charles E. Darling of Enfield.

Charles E. Darling; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$25 per week be, and hereby is, granted to Charles E. Darling, of Enfield, to be paid monthly from the funds of the Maine State Retirement System to increase the pension he is now receiving. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1953 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Darling was granted a state pension of \$8.60 per week on June 5, 1936 by Council Order No. 196. He had been for 30 years a hatchery employee of the inland fisheries and game department.
