HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S. P. 493, L. D. 1347, Resolve to

Apportion One Hundred and Fifty-one
Representatives Among the Several Counties,
Cities, Towns, Plantations and Classes
in the State of Maine

Amend said Resolve by striking out the paragraph which relates to the "County of Kennebec" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The county of Kennebec shall choose 13 representatives
to be apportioned as follows: Augusta, two representatives;
Waterville, two representatives; Gardiner, one representative;
Albion, Benton, Clinton, and Unity Plantation, one representative;
Albion, Benton, Clinton, and Unity Plantation, one representative; Chelsea
and Farmingdale, one representative; China, Pittston,
Randolph, and Windsor, one representative; Hallowell, Manchester,
and West Gardiner, one representative; Litchfield, Monmouth,
and Winthrop, one representative; Fayette, Mt. Vernon, Readfield,
Rome, Wayne, and Vienna, one representative; Belgrade, Oakland,
and Sidney, one representative.'
