HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to S. P. 493, L. D. 1347, Resolve to
Apportion One Hundred and Fifty-one
Representatives Among the Several Counties,
Cities, Towns, Plantations and Classes
in the State of Maine.

Amend said Resolve by striking out the paragraph which
relates to the "County of Kennebec" and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'The county of Kennebec shall choose 13 representatives
to be apportioned as follows: Augusta, three representatives;
Waterville, two representatives; Gardiner, one representative;
Sidney, Belgrade, Oakland and Rome, one representative;
Readfield, Mount Vernon, Vienna, Wayne, Fayette, Monmouth
and Litchfield, one representative; Winthrop, Manchester
and West Gardiner, one representative; China, Pittston,
Randolph and Windsor, one representative; Albion, Benton,
Clinton, Unity Plantation and Vassalboro, one representative;
Winslow, one representative; Chelsea, Farmingdale and
Hallowell, one representative.'
