**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-THREE**

RESOLVE, in Favor of Ray Spearen, of South China.

Ray Spearen; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$35.90 to be paid to Ray Spearen, of South China, to compensate him for a suit of clothes taken by an escapee from the men's reformatory.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In October, 1952, an escapee of the men's reformatory took a suit of clothes from Mr. Spearen's car which was parked in his yard. Later the suit was identified by markings, upon recapture of the escapee.
