#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Myrtie M. Brown, of China.

Myrtie M. Brown; pension for. Resolved: That a pension of \$33.67 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Myrtie M. Brown, of China, to be paid monthly from the funds of the Maine State Retirement System to increase the pension she is now receiving under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1951 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Myrtie M. Brown now receives from teacher's retirement a pension of \$66.33 per month. She is now 76 years of age. Her room and board at Wilson Nursing home is \$25 per week.
