SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 509, L. D. 1388, Bill "An Act
relating to the Sales Tax on Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by inserting immediately before the
enacting clause thereof, the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, the recently enacted sales
tax has imposed a severe financial burden upon the motor vehicle
buying public of the state of Maine; and

Whereas, a motor vehicle is an actively traded commodity,
thus frequently the subject of the sales tax; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health
and safety; now therefore'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in
the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.'
