RESOLVE, to Reimburse J. J. Blackmore of Berwick for Damage Done by State Wards.

J. J. Blackmore; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$87.85 from the general fund to be paid to J. J. Blackmore, of Berwick, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his diner by two state wards.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In November 1951 two state wards damaged Mr. Blackmore's diner. Property owners should be reimbursed for the damage caused by these two boys.
