IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Moses A. Dolley, of Vassalboro.

Moses A. Dolley; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$567.33 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Moses A. Dolley, of Vassalboro, to compensate him for injuries received while working for the state highway commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On June 11, 1940, Mr. Dolley was injured while working for the state highway commission. He was paid compensation for varying amounts not exceeding \$11.20 per week until March 7, 1946. The industrial accident commission found him only partially incapacitated on April 26, 1946 and his payments stopped as he had received the maximum allowed by law for partial incapacity. On February 24, 1947 his doctor found him totally incapacitated. This resolve is to compensate Mr. Dolley for the period in question, at \$11.20 per week.
