RESOLVE, in Favor of Wesley Ramsey, of South Portland.

Wesley Ramsey; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$206.50 to be paid to Wesley Ramsey, of South Portland, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for damage to home and personal property by escapees from the state school for boys.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On December 29, 1952, damage was done by 2 boys, who escaped from the state school for boys, to the home and some personal property of Mr. and Mrs. Wesley Ramsey, 49 Wescott Road, South Portland, estimated as follows:
