SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1246, L. D. 1452, Bill "An
Act Relating to Joint Tenancies Between
Husband and Wife."

Amend said Bill by striking out the Title thereof and
inserting in place thereof the following Title:

'An Act Relating to a Method of Creating Joint Tenancies
in Real Property.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the last underlined
sentence and inserting in place thereof the following under-
lined sentence:

'Estates in joint tenancy so created shall have and possess
all of the attributes and incidents of estates in joint
tenancy created or existing at common law and the rights and
liabilities of the tenants in estates in joint tenancy so
created shall be the same as in estates in joint tenancy
created or existing at common law.'
