#### STATE OF MAINE

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Castle Hill.

Town of Castle Hill; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$436.48 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Castle Hill, to reimburse said town for supplies and medical aid extended to Lorena and Dorenne Boulley; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Between December 31, 1949 and November 30, 1950, the town of Castle Hill expended the sum of \$812.45 to the Donald Boulley family for pauper supplies. The state reimbursed the sum of \$375.97 leaving a balance of \$436.48 still due. This sum represents the amount expended directly for Lorena and Dorenne Boulley, state paupers.
