STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Attorney-General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 17, § 1, amended. The 6th sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 1 of chapter 17 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The attorney-general shall have an office in the state capitol and shall receive an annual salary of \$7,000 \$8,000 in full for all services and in lieu of all fees.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall become effective for the week ending July 11, 1953.
