STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR

AN ACT Authorizing the Building of a Foot Bridge Across Tidewaters in Gilpatrick's Cove in the Town of Mount Desert.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1895, c. 155, repealed and replaced. Chapter 155 of the private and special laws of 1895 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Elizabeth Flagler Harris authorized to construct and maintain foot bridge. Elizabeth Flagler Harris, one of the respective grantees of William Warren Vaughan, is hereby authorized to reconstruct and maintain a foot bridge from her land at Smallidge Point, Northeast Harbor, in the town of Mount Desert, County of Hancock, across Gilpatrick's Cove, so called, to cr towards the highway lying easterly of her land and others situated on said Smallidge Point.
