SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1311, L. D. 1580, Bill "An Act
to Repeal the Tax on Cigars and Tobacco
Products."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 15 thereof
a new section to be numbered 15-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 15-A. Repeal of exemption of cigars and tobacco
products under sales and use tax law. No tax on sales, storage
or use shall be collected upon or in connection with sales of
cigarettes.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof
the following section:

'Sec. 18. Intention. It is the intention of the
legislature to repeal any law or part thereof which taxes
cigars or tobacco products; and that after January 1, 1955
there will be no tax on cigars and tobacco products, except
under the provisions of the sales and use tax law.'
