**RESOLVE, Approving Draft and Arrangement of the State Constitution
Made by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court, and Providing
for its Publication and Distribution.**

Constitution; approval of draft and arrangement, enrollment, publication, distribution. Resolved: That the draft and arrangement of the constitution of the state, as amended, made by the chief justice of the supreme judicial court, in pursuance of section 6 of article X of the constitution, is hereby approved, and that the same be enrolled on parchment or other suitable material and deposited in the office of the secretary of state; and be it further

Resolved: That the secretary of state be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to cause said constitution, as amended and arranged, to be enrolled on parchment, or other suitable material and, under the seal of the state, to attest to the correctness of such enrollment; and be it further

Resolved: That the secretary of state be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to cause to be published in pamphlet form copies of the constitution of the state, in such numbers as he deems necessary, and that one copy of the same be forwarded to the municipal officers of each city and town and to the assessors of each plantation within the state.
