HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1266, Resolve, Granting a Complimentary Fishing License to the President of the United States.

Amend said Resolve in the Title by adding after the words "United States" the words 'of America'

Further amend said Resolve by adding after the words "United States" in the 1st line thereof the words 'of America'

Further amend said Resolve in the 9th line by adding after the words "United States" the words 'of America'

Further amend said Resolve in the 20th line by adding after the words "United States" the words 'of America and to Mamie Doud Eisenhower, his wife'

Further amend said Resolve in the 23rd line by striking out the word "license" and inserting in place thereof the word 'licenses'
