**AN ACT Relating to Rabbit Hunting in Oxford, Franklin and Somerset Counties.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 37, § 106, amended.** The first paragraph of section 106 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘There shall be a closed season on wild hares or rabbits from the 1st day of March to the 30th day of the following September, both days inclusive, **except in the counties of Franklin, Oxford and Somerset where there shall be a closed season from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of the following September, both days inclusive.**’
