Resolve, to Apportion One Hundred and Fifty-  
one Representatives Among the Several Counties,

Amend said Amendment by striking out the 9th line thereof and  
inserting in place thereof the following:

'and Jonesport, one representative; Lubec, Machiasport, Tres-  
cott, Whiting, Charlotte,'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out the comma and  
word Charlotte in the 3rd line from the end thereof.
