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**AN ACT Repealing Separate Bids for Purchase of Institutional Supplies.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 16, § 37, repealed.** Section 37 of chapter 16 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed as follows:

~~'Sec. 37. Institution supplies to be bid for separately. The state purchasing agent, in requesting bids for institutional supplies, shall list the articles on which bids are requested under the names of the institutions for which they are desired. Bids shall be made on any or all of the articles listed, each bid being made for the supply of a specific article or articles to the particular institution without reference to those otherwise listed.'~~
