AN ACT Relating to Expenditure of Town Road Improvement Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 62, amended. Section 62 of chapter 23 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 62. Expenditures. The expenditures of this fund shall not exceed the sum of ~~\$3,000~~ \$5,000 in any 1 mile. The various towns shall furnish all local road material, including rocks, sand, gravel, etc., and shall assume and pay any cost or damages arising from any change in location, grade or drainage.'
