RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Steuben.

Town of Steuben; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$1,846.12 to be paid to the town of Steuben to reimburse them for aid given to Blake Barclay and family, in supplying food, medicine, hospitalization, etc.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Blake Barclay and his family, consisting of his wife and 5 minor children received aid and assistance from the town of Steuben from August 6, 1949 to April 10, 1951, and March 1952 up to the present time, in the amount of \$1,846.12.
